BOARD OF SELECTMEN

MINUTES
February 22, 2005

Vice Chairman Paul M. Gallagher opened the meeting of the Board of Selectmen held on February 22, 2005 at 7:30 p.m. in Room 200 at the Town House, 26 Evergreen Street, Kingston. Present were Olavo B. DeMacedo and Joseph D. Kelleher, and Town Administrator Kevin R. Donovan. Chairman Mark S. Beaton and Richard E. Kenney were absent.

The Chairman announced the dates to note and the Open Forum.

Thomas Bott came forward to announce that he would be participating in the Polar Plunge on March 5, 2005, a fundraiser for Jordan Hospital and requested individuals that want to make a pledge of support to contact him.

Jean Landis Naumann was present on behalf of the Kingston Reads program and announced the kickoff program would take place on March 5, 2005 at 2:00 p.m. at the Kingston Public Library. Ms. Naumann provided details of the many events that were taking place intended to encourage reading the selected books on the topic of baseball. Members of the Board expressed their support for the program.

The Board reviewed the Town Administrator's report. Mr. Kelleher noted that the Town anticipated 75% reimbursement for costs associated with two storms since fourteen counties had been declared disaster areas. Also noted was the Silver Lake Regional School Budget projected to increase Kingston's share by \$524,753. Mr. Gallagher announced that the deed for the land purchased for the Senior Center had been recorded and that the Town now owns the land adjacent to the Municipal Complex.
