MINUTES
January 25, 2005

Vice Chairman Paul Gallagher opened the meeting of the Board of Selectmen held on January 25, 2005 at 7:30 p.m. in Room 200 at the Town House, 26 Evergreen Street, Kingston. Present were Olavo B.
