Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Nava.

The 7:30 appointment was with 5 members of the Kingston Garden Club. The two groups discussed working together to develop a farmers' market in Kingston in July and August. Joan volunteered to investigate how we could work with WIC. Beth volunteered to find out who runs the Plymouth market. Bill volunteered to get a guest speaker for the March 8 meeting. Members of the garden club will be invited to the March meeting as will Dick Ward from Carver.

Bill recommended that we considering forming subcommittees to handle details. Someone mentioned that the vendors in Plymouth pay \$3 per week. There was also discussion of involving the scout troops. The garden club members left after this discussion.

Members of the commission discussed the warrant articles on proposed zoning by law changes. Bill mentioned that there are State rules covering more than 5 acres. Bill will contact Ms. Cole to discuss the details of her proposed changes.

Bill also agreed to work on a right-to-farm by law that the commission could consider for a future town meeting.
