

IMPORTANT DATES FOR KINGSTON PROPERTY OWNERS

January 1st

“Assessment date” for the following fiscal year. 1/1/2011 for Fiscal Year 2012.

February 1st

The 3rd quarter bill is due. It is the final date on which an abatement application can be filed for that year. The CPA exemption application is also due.

March 1st

Due date 3ABC filing for exempt entities, and Personal Property Form of List.

March 31st

Last day to file exemption, hardship and tax deferral applications.

May 2nd

The 4th quarter actual tax bill is due.

July 1st

Beginning of the fiscal year.

August 1st

The 1st quarter preliminary tax bill is due, and the due date for Boat Form of List.

September 1st

Exemption applications can be submitted to the Board of Assessors.

November 1st

The 2nd quarter preliminary tax bill is due.

December 30th

Mailing of the 3rd quarter actual tax bill, which reflects the new assessment and the new tax rate. Abatement applications are available at the Assessors’ Office and on the Town of Kingston’s website.
