7:15p.m. – 7:30p.m. - Opening of a Public Hearing for Foster Lane, Map 36, Lot 35

The Kingston Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing on the request filed by Timothy F. Shea. Location of the proposed project is Foster Lane, Map 36, Lot 35, Kingston, MA. For work described in the Request for Determination of Applicability to place a shed on concrete blocks within the 100' buffer zone to the top of a coastal bank and within the outer riparian zone to Stony Brook.

For work described in the Notice of Intent to construct a parking lot and associated stormwater management system with associated grading and landscaping within the 100' buffer zone to a Bordering Vegetated Wetland and within the Outer Riparian Zone of Mile Brook.

The applicant has filed an Abbreviated Notice of Resource Area Delineation consisting of 1880 linear feet of bordering vegetated wetland, the 100' buffer zone and the Riverfront Area.

Location of the proposed project is 55 Landing Road, Map 37, Lot 51, Kingston, MA. For work described in the Request for Determination of Applicability to replace the existing chain link fence with a stone wall approximately 275 linear feet and to construct a Photovoltaic array within the 200' Riverfront Area to the Jones River and Stony Brook and within the 100' buffer zone to a bordering vegetated wetland.
