7:30p.m. – 8:00p.m. - Continuation of a Public Hearing for Cranberry Road & Smith's Lane NOI

The Kingston Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing on the request filed by Thorndike Development Corporation. Location of the proposed project is Route 3 northbound ramps at Exit 8 and Cranberry Road, Map 76, Lots 4 and 8, Kingston, MA. For work described in the Notice of Intent to upgrade the existing northbound ramps at Exit 8 on Route 3 and reconstruct a portion of Cranberry Road. Work includes installation of erosion controls, clearing, earthwork, installation of above ground and subsurface utilities, paving, adding sidewalks, guardrail installation, landscaping and a BVW enhancement area of 2200 square feet. Proposed work is within the Riverfront Area to Smelt Brook and within 100' of Bordering Vegetated Wetlands.

The Kingston Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing on the request filed by the Jones River Watershed Association. Location of the proposed project is 26 Wapping Road, Map 44, Lot 49, Kingston, MA. For work described in the Request for Determination of Applicability to temporarily draw down the waters impounded behind the dam at Wapping Road during lowest flows for the collection of field data.

8:15p.m. – 8:30p.m. – Opening of a Public Hearing for Pembroke Street (Route 27) between Grove Street and Country Way

The Kingston Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing on the request filed by NSTAR Gas Company. Location of the proposed project is Pembroke Street (Route 27) between Grove Street and Country Way, Kingston, MA. For work described in the Notice of Intent to install approximately 2700 linear meters of 8-inch diameter plastic pipe, 175 linear meters of 4-inch pipe and 75 linear meters of 2-inch pipe within the roadway easement and in the shoulder area just off the edge of the pavement where possible.
