Health Agent's Report

Beach Samples continue to be tested on a weekly basis and will continue through Labor Day. Results continue to fall well within State guide lines, weekly results are submitted to the Department of Public Health Sanitation Department.

Correspondence was put together regarding all the enforcement orders that have been sent to Attorney Geary, to abandon his septic system at 161 Summer Street. And all the letters that were sent beginning in January 2009. All documents regarding abandonment of a septic system. Last year on September 22, 2008, the Board of Health adopted a regulation which was spear headed by Chairman, Joe Casna and a Public Hearing was held, (No property owner whose property abuts a way in which an active public sewer line has been laid, will be permitted to maintain, construct, upgrade, or replace a septic system, except provided in Section(D), "Special Exceptions." of these regulations.

Jack Breen asked if we have anyone else who has not abandonment their system in the Town? The answer is no. The Sewer Department has been trying to get him to abandon his system and he has not complied, the regulation states one system per lot. Joe Casna said that Attorney Geary has got to come into the next meeting and be prepared to apply for a variance so which we can vote or we give him the order to abandon. Bill Watson said okay if we want to wait another couple of weeks, we have already waited 7 months.

Motion: Jack Breen, that this Board support enforcement of everything discussed here tonight and force the abandonment forthwith, if he feels he wants a variance, he can come to us at anytime.

Discussion: Jack Breen said I don't want 20 people coming in to the next meeting and asking us why they had to abandon their septic system and he doesn't.
