Health Agent's Report

The Health Agent informed the Board about the H1N1 vaccine she would like to release 400 doses to the South Shore Medical Clinic, and 100 doses to Partners Home Care. Bill Watson does not agree with releasing any vaccine to South Shore Medical Center. There was a lengthy discussion. Most of the Board Members agreed with the Health Agent about releasing the vaccine.

Seasonal Flu Clinic held October 8th, and November 4th, a total of 375 doses were administered.
