This was never talked about with the Board. We should ask the Agricultural Representative to our meeting and explain it to us just what it is that they want us to do. We are an appointed board, this is a by-law and the Board is not bound by this. Bill Watson thinks we should ask Town Clerk, Mary Lou Murzan to write a letter to Attorney General. Dan said he would talk to Mary Lou tomorrow about this issue.

Smoke from neighbors stove permeating house next door, no permit was ever issued for the stove. The Board wants Henny to go to the neighbor and ask him not to burn in the stove until he gets a permit and if the problem continues, he will have to come before the board.

Dan asked about the new Food Inspector this week. Dan said we should ask Henny to have Mr. Murphy provide a disclosure to the Clerk's Office.
