New Business

Joe said it was leaking out of a plastic tank. And what my company was going to do, was pump what was left in their tank and put it in our tank. Joe said Henny came down when I was there. Clean Harbors was also called in.

Old/ Business

Dan asked what did we do about the AED's from last meeting. Nothing was done after Town Counsel left the last meeting, after he made his recommendations, the Board said nothing further about them. Dan said to establish a by-law through Town Meeting. Dan said we will have to get together and set this up for Town Meeting. Dan thinks the Attorney's letter from Tree Top made sense. I don't think they fall under this nor do daycare centers. He talked about physical therapy and health clubs. Jack Breen spoke about talking to the APTA and if you know the history of your patient, you should be aware of their health and what you can have them do. They do not need them at physical therapy. Anytime Fitness may be in trouble. Dan said we need to set time aside to get ready for Town Meeting. Set a half hour to work on this. Dan said we will be the first BOH to make these regulations.

Bill Kavol asked if Henny talked to anyone from tobacco collaborative about the tobacco problem, Bill W. Said our agent can do the inspections. Next meeting ask Henny to speak about tobacco issue. Joe said prior to anyone doing that, you have to be trained.
