

ASSESSORS MEETING
TOWN HALL
SEPTEMBER 16, 2008

The Board was called to order at 6:30 p.m. Anne Dunn, Tom Donnelly, and Nancy Shea were present.

Upon motion made and seconded, the Board –

VOTED: to approve the minutes of the meeting of August 26, 2008.

The Board reviewed and signed office bills.

Upon review of applications and supporting documentation, the Board:

GRANTED: property tax exemptions to qualified individuals based upon veteran status, disability, financial means and senior status.

The Board reviewed the Community Preservation Act Surcharge Report.

The Board discussed the Classification Hearing to be held at 7 p.m. with the Board of Selectmen. Chairwoman Dunn reviewed the points she intended to make in her presentation to the Selectmen, together with supplemental materials she had prepared for use in response to possible questions. The Board confirmed its prior decision to unanimously recommend retention of a single tax rate.

At 7 p.m., the Board adjourned to join the Board of Selectmen. Commencing at approximately 7:10 p.m., the Board of Assessors and the Board of Selectmen jointly held the Classification Hearing. After presentation by Chairwoman Dunn, upon motion made and seconded by Selectmen, the Board of Selectmen voted to adopt a single tax rate for all classes of property in the Town of Kingston for Fiscal Year 2009.

The Classification Hearing was then adjourned.

The next meeting of the Board of Assessors will be held Tuesday, October 28th at 4:00 p.m.
