The Recreation Commission held its regular scheduled meeting on Monday June 4, 2007 , at the Reed Community Building, 33 A Summer St., Kingston, Ma 02364.
Vice-Chairperson Paul Maloney called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM.

Commission reviewed the meeting minutes from the meeting of April and May.

Motion

Motion made by Ken Moalli, second by Linda Rohr, to accept both the meeting minutes from the April and May meetings.

Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

Open forum

Nancy Massman attended meeting on the behalf of the Stop and Shop Jimmy Fund, fundraiser. Nancy would ask the Commission to waive the fee of the fields in lieu of the work that the group did at the Reed fields.

Motion

Motion was made by Linda Felix, second by Linda Rohr, to waive the fee for the fields for the Stop and Shop fundraiser.

Discussion

Ken Moalli asks to have the motion amended.

Amended Motion

Motion made by Ken Moalli, second by Linda Felix, to waive the Stop and Shop fundraiser field fee, in lieu of work performed by the group on the reed fields.

Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

Susan updated the commission on the status of the beach hut. The BOH will let us open for this year with the repairs that have been completed, but will need more updates before the opening next year. Expenses could be as much as \$10,000. Susan also stated that Nancy Howlett is investigating the possibility of a long term lease for next years bid.

Susan updated Commission on the FY08 budget status. Susan asks Commission for input on presentation to the BOS.

Motion

Motion was made by Linda Rohr, second by Ken Moalli, to close building as necessary to cover the loss of utilities cut from the budget.

Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

Susan updated commission on the status of the fields. The filtration system was not hooked up correctly at the beginning, and the shed floor was not installed correctly. At this point, the filtration system is up and running 100 percent, the irrigation is still not working properly. The back field, the irrigation is not working at all. Turf management has gone in and started. The Rizzo field is closed for the remainder of the year.

Field budget update. The \$24,000 expected from T mobile, will not be applied this fiscal year. Susan stated possibility of July or August. Susan reviewed the field budget in detail, please see attached sheet.

Motion

Paul Maloney made a motion, second by Norman Harbinson, to Have the KYSO fee for FY08 to be set at \$28,000, to be paid quarterly. First quarter \$5000, second \$5000, third \$9000, and fourth \$9000.

Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

Member Ken Moalli updated the commission on his meeting with the CPA. Ken stated that there is an update on the change of laws regarding recreational use, in front of the senate. The applications for CPC are due by November 1, 2007.

Susan asks Commission to decide the field fees for FY08.

Motion

Motion was made by Linda Rohr, second by Norman Harbinson, to change the fee for fiscal year FY08 to \$25.00 per hour with a two hour minimum.

Amended Motion

Motion was amended by Norman Harbinson, second by Paul Maloney, to raise the fee for the Rizzo field to \$100.00 per hour with a two hour minimum, and 25.00 an hour with a two hour minimum on all other fields for fiscal year FY08.

Discussion

Commission discussed. Linda Felix stated that the fees were already to high and should not be increased. Commission stated compared to other towns, fees are still minimal.

Motion passed by a 4-1-0 voice vote.

Commissioners reorganized their committee. Ken Moalli nominated Paul Maloney for Chairperson, Norman Harbinson second.

Linda Felix nominated Norman Harbinson for vice chairperson, Linda Rohr second.

Paul Maloney will be Chairperson, and Norman Harbinson, Vice-Chairperson.

Commission needed to reorganize and review individual responsibilities.

Ken Moalli will oversee the CPA and fields at both Reed and Opachinski.

Linda Rohr will assist with programs.

Paul Maloney will oversee fields at both locations.

Linda Felix will assist with programs and concerns at the Reed Building

Norman Harbinson will oversee Grays beach, Camp Nekon.

Susan asks for any agenda items for the next scheduled meeting. Linda Felix asks to discuss the rental of

equipment at Grays beach park.
