MINUTES  
March 18, 2009

Chairman Paul M. Gallagher opened the meeting of the Board of Selectmen held on March 18, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. in Room 200 at the Town House, 26 Evergreen Street, Kingston. Present were Vice Chairman Sandra D. MacFarlane, Mark S. Beaton, Jean Landis-Naumann, Dennis N. Randall and Interim Town Administrator John F. Healey.

The Chairman stated the special meeting was being held to interview three candidates for the Town Administrator position that were recommended by the Town Administrator Search Committee. Mr. Gallagher thanked the Committee for their work in bringing forward the three candidates; Troy Clarkson, Jill Myers, and Mark Stankiewicz.

Candidates were each interviewed for approximately one hour and only the candidate being interviewed was present in the room for the interview. Each candidate was offered the opportunity to make a presentation of their qualifications and experience. Board members each posed questions to the candidates, asking the same or similar questions to each candidate.

The Board took a brief break between the second and third interview and returned to conduct the final interview at 9:00 p.m.

The consensus was to meet on Tuesday, March 25, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. to determine the candidate that would be offered the position of Town Administrator and to enter into negotiations for the terms of the contract.
