BOARD OF SELECTMEN

MINUTES  
April 25, 2007

Chairman Joseph D. Kelleher opened the meeting of the Board of Selectmen held on April 25, 2007 at 6:30 pm in Kingston Intermediate School Auditorium, 65 Second Brook Street, Kingston. Present were Mark S. Beaton, Jean Landis-Naumann, Sandra D. MacFarlane and Town Administrator Kevin R. Donovan. Paul M. Gallagher arrived at 6:45 p.m.

Chairman Kelleher opened the hearing for the joint pole location on Bradford Avenue. Mr. Darryl Crossman was there representing Verizon.

Upon motion made and seconded, following a discussion and a 4-0-0 vote, it was –

VOTED: To close the public hearing.

VOTED: The petition to place a new pole 18/10 on Bradford Avenue, and to grant permission to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings.

VOTED: To accept the minutes of the public and executive session meetings of March 13, 2007 and April 3, 2007.

VOTED: To call a Special Town Election for Saturday, June 9, 2007, with the questions as detailed in the Warrant.

VOTED: To appoint Rui David Santos to the Frederick C. Adams Heritage Center Committee, and John Cram as a Volunteer for the Kingston Emergency Management Agency.

VOTED: To have a joint meeting with the Kingston Housing Authority on May 8, 2007 to fill the vacancy on the Committee.

There was a discussion regarding the NOI Fund Payment for Invoice 68315 to Anderson & Kreiger LLP. Ms. Landis-Naumann would like clarification of the previous balance and what it was for. Ms. MacFarlane questioned the hourly rate as being more than other consultants used by the Town, and if the Town Administrator had given permission to use a firm previously approved for use by the Town.

Upon motion made and seconded, following a discussion and a 4-0-0 vote, it was –

VOTED: To have the Conservation Commission get a new itemized invoice.

VOTED: To deny the request to abate the ambulance bill for December 29, 2006 in the amount of \$437.94.

The request for ambulance abatement for May 13, 2006 Run No. 58767 in the amount of \$463.35 needs to provide more information regarding income and relationship of person signing form to person services were provided to.

VOTED: To allow the Kingston Cub Scouts Pack #49 use of the Town Green for a flag retirement ceremony on Thursday June 14, 2007 at 6:30 pm.

VOTED: To request a joint meeting with the Historical Commission regarding the letter dated April 14, 2007 sent to the Board.

Mr. Gallagher arrived at the meeting at 6:43 pm.

VOTED: To approve financial aid request up to \$1525.00 for camperships to Camp Squanto in July.

VOTED: To reconvene the meeting at 7:00 pm at the continued session of the Annual Town Meeting.
