MINUTES
July 26, 2005

Vice Chairman Joseph D. Kelleher opened the meeting of the Board of Selectmen held on July 26, 2005 at 7:30 p.m. in Room 200 at the Town House, 26 Evergreen Street, Kingston. Present were Mark S. Beaton, Olavo B. DeMacedo, Sandra D. MacFarlane and Town Administrator Kevin R. Donovan. Chairman Gallagher was absent.

The Vice Chairman announced the dates to note and the Open Forum. No one came forward to speak at Open Forum.

Upon motion made and seconded, following a discussion and a 4 to 0 to 0 vote, it was –

VOTED: To accept the minutes of the June 12, 2005 public session meeting.

There were no comments on the Town Administrator's report.

Upon motion made and seconded, following a discussion and a 3 to 0 to 0 vote, it was –

VOTED: To accept the donation of water bottles from a disaster mitigation company for the Fire Department and the donation to the Recreation Department of a hot dog steamer, safety netting, a public address system, and Solar lights for the parking lot at Opachinski Field, and furth;

VOTED: To waive the ambulance fee for a resident due to a financial hardship, and further;

VOTED: To approve the payment of \$1,106.00 from the Wetland's Protection Fund to Mainstream Eng. for riverfront calculations.

Mr. Beaton noted that the Silver Lake Regional School Committee would be meeting on teacher contract negotiations on Wednesday and expressed that he hoped the contract would be settled at this meeting.
