Minutes  
February 22, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7 pm meeting. Elaine Fiore, Peter Cobb and Thomas Taylor were present.

Bill schedules for \$120.44, \$671.39, and \$40,200.18 were signed. A memo regarding the betterment payoff for 56 Main St. was signed.

Ms. Fiore reported that Don Freeman of CDM is at 95 % completion of the ground water discharge permit. The next step is a meeting with DEP. Don Freeman to coordinate and will notify us of meeting date.

Jeff Gould from DEP called Ms. Fiore regarding a failing septic system at Conifer Green. He was inquiring about having them connect to the municipal sewer system, because they are in Zone 2 (an area with water wells). DEP's first choice for them would be municipal sewer. Treatment for 12,000 – 15,000 GPD of flow is estimated to be needed. Mr. Cobb mentioned that this would entail crossing the Jones River. He also questioned whether the existing pump stations are equipped to handle the additional flow. Office staff is to research how many additional properties are along Wapping Rd. and South St.

Ms. Fiore would like to review the Rules and Regulations to make failed systems as recognized by DEP a priority to service. She'd like to cover the Rules and Regulations at the Public Hearing scheduled for March 22, 2011. The postcards and newspaper advertisement for the Public hearing were reviewed. Cost estimates were reviewed for the printing and postage.

Ms. Fiore moved to accept the Minutes of January 25, 2011; February 8, 2011 and Executive Session February 8, 2011. Mr. Cobb seconded. All VOTED to accept January 25<sup>th</sup> Minutes. Ms. Fiore and Mr. Cobb VOTED to accept February 8<sup>th</sup> Minutes, both sets, as Mr. Taylor was not present that evening.

Ms. Fiore asked if there was anything new on the Hilltop generator. There is an Article for Spring Town meeting and funds should be available July 1, 2011. Follow up with Supt. Vandal to see where he is at regarding the generator.

Mr. Cobb moved to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Taylor seconded. Meeting adjourned at 8pm.
