A regular meeting of the Board of Water Commissioners/Water Quality Review Committee was held on Tuesday, May 12, 2009 in the Michael G. MacPherson Meeting Room at the Elm Street Pumping Station and was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by the Chairman, Robert R. Kostka. Present were: Robert R. Kostka, Fred D. Svenson, Jr., Richard W. Loring, Jr., Matthew J. Darsch, Superintendent and Marylou Joyce, Clerk. Mark Devine of Coler & Colantonio was late.

#### APPOINTMENTS

##### Matthew J. Darsch, Superintendent

Superintendent Darsch stated that we are still working on isolating the break in the 6" water main under the Jones River. A repair to the gate at Brook Street will be done Thursday. Residents of Second Brook Street and off Second Brook Street have been notified of the work to be done. When this is complete work will begin on Main Street.

The contractor is laying water main on Pembroke Street. The first section has been chlorinated.

Well Cleaning at Trackle Pond - Trackle Pond was treated with acid four times and has now been restored to its original capacity. We did not exceed the developmental time and the new pump has been ordered.

Superintendent Darsch informed the board that a round table discussion would be held tomorrow on the 1021 Kingston's Place 40R project.

The board reviewed and unanimously approved the request to install a sprinkler system at the Firefighter's Memorial (See 6a). Ms. Joyce will prepare a letter.

The board reviewed the request for a copy of the lists of accounts receiving a shut-off notice from Bob Ward of 13 School St. Ms. Joyce will comply with this request.

##### Mark Devine—Coler & Colantonio

Mark presented a change order and final pay request from McLaughlin Brothers—Pottle Street Crossing. These were approved and signed. Ms. Joyce will forward them to the town hall.

Mark Devine stated that had received but had not replied to an email from Lindsey Wagner regarding the proposal of 1021 Kingston's Place. Mark is preparing a list of comments on the plan. In the meantime the Town Planner has requested comments. Ms. Joyce will prepare a letter stating several of our concerns.

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Superintendent Darsch will contact the consultant to the Sisters of Divine Providence to check on the status of their proposed development and our need for the well site at Muddy Pond. We will arrange a meeting with them.

Mark commented on his meeting with representatives of MA Highway regarding Pembroke Street. The board instructed him to continue to insist that we do not think the culverts are adequate.

The Trackle Pond Well Cleaning is complete—we will await the lab work that should arrive in a few weeks.

We reviewed the 1-86 pump station construction plans. Mark expects them to be complete in six more weeks. The board instructed Mark to prepare a bid for limited site work.
