- **Dredging Sub-Committee Report** – No Report
- **Historical Restoration of Town Landing** – Ronald R. Bourne, P.E. of Bourne Consulting Engineering was invited to present the options for the improvements of the wharf to restore the historic nature while providing modern services in support of the wharf and marine operations. There were three options for the Kingston Waterfront Committee to take under advisement:
 - Option 1 – Based on repairing and improving the existing conditions of the site. This option results in no significant changes to the facility but includes upland, utility and stone wharf improvements.
 - Option 2 – This option is based on improving the wharf for pedestrian use and upgrades the wharf to prevent flooding by raising the wharf. This option has more upland, utility, aesthetic and town wharf improvements.

- Option 3 – This option addresses functionality of the space in terms of pedestrians and motorists but also the overall historic character of the area.

Mr. Catani commented that raising the pier by 2 feet may interfere with trucks/trailers landing boats.

Additionally, test pits will need to be dug and a site survey will be needed. It was thought that there may be a site survey from approximately eight years ago that may be used.
