Harbormaster's Report –

- In March, meeting with the finance commission to get 8 –10 channel markers for Rocky Nook and the five more needed for the main dock. There are five old floaters that will be painted white for no wake signs across Rocky Nook mooring area.
- There will be no Homeland Security cameras for the towns of the bay due to lack of federal funds, at least for the near future. However, security cameras are needed because of theft in the pier area.
- Inflatable boat is back

Old Business -

- Dredging Sub-Committee Report – No Report
- Historical Restoration of Town Landing – As a follow up to the October 3, 2011 KWC meeting where Ronald R. Bourne of Bourne Engineering Consultants met with the Committee. He presented three options for the Town Wharf restoration which were detailed in a letter to the Committee dated September 27, 2011. Of those options, and after considerable discussion, the Committee recommends Option 2 with some changes. This option upgrades the wharf by stabilizing seawalls, makes some upland improvements, achieves safety improvements, provides better utility services to pier and in general improves the aesthetics and functionality of the area, with the following exceptions/adjustments:

- No elevation change from present
- Eliminate gangway
- Use asphalt pavement with a crown to facilitate drainage and runoff of debris, no concrete
- No floats as described adjacent to pier
- Eliminate dumpster fence
- No ornamental railing
- Bollards should have removable chain
- Ornamental lights should be historical/period lighting gas type in appearance on dock and walkway
- Keep two of the benches
- Add (2) 4 inch conduits for future

The next steps in this project would be to dig test pits and follow up meeting, perhaps on site with Ron Bourne.
