### Old Business:

1. ATON (Aids to Navigation): Ms. Bloomquist presented an overview of registration of ATON process. Lat/Long understood to be approximate and is updated annually by the Regional USCG ATON Coordinator. Mr. Carvalho will update registration and log-in access on [www.usharbormaster.com](http://www.usharbormaster.com).
2. Commercial shellfish licensure: 2 licenses will be approved by HM based on report received from the State Fisheries and Aquaculture Woods Hole Extension Service. Only a small area of razor clams will be so let. The Committee voted unanimous support on a motion from Mr. Loring Seconded by Mr. Veno.
3. Fees: Set fees and asked that a letter be sent by the Secretary to the Selectmen regarding current fees and FY 2010 fee process.
4. By-Laws: Affirmed by unanimous vote changes where typos existed.
5. Voted unanimously on a motion by Mr. Murray, Seconded by Mr. Cazeault that Section D be amended to include Paragraph 4 to state that the Maximum length of a boat on a A, B or C Docks so named, be limited to 21 feet of manufacturers registered length and that any appendages (motors, pulpits, etc) be regulated at the discretion of the Harbormaster with reference to safety and effects on the integrity of the docks.

### New Business:

1. GPS: The Harbormaster's vessels do not have GPS. This safety device is necessary for the safety of the mariners. The Committee voted unanimously, on a Motion by Mr. Veno, Seconded by Mr. Murray to provide a portable GPS unit out of the WIF.
2. Aquaculture: The Harbormaster will attend the June 23, 2009 Selectman's meeting to explain the plans for effective implementation of the aquaculture initiative.
3. The Committee unanimously, on a Motion by Mr. Veno, Seconded by Mr. Guidoboni directed the secretary to send a letter to the selectmen informing them of the Committees recommendation the Mr. Carvalho be named permanent Harbormaster.
4. The Committee by consensus instructed the Secretary to send two letters to the Selectman pertaining to (1) Fees and Shellfish Advisory Committee (2) Unanimous support for elevating Mr. Carvalho to permanent Harbrmaster with a request that these items be placed on the June 23 agenda for the Selectman's meeting.
