Discussion:

1. HM reported that there were 12 new moorings added this year. IN addition, non-paying users were removed and their moorings let to 18 people on the waiting list. Mr. Guidoboni moved: That a subcommittee be formed to propose 2010 fee schedule to KWC in October. Seconded Mr. Cazealt. Voted Unanimously. Mr. Guidoboni and Mr. Murray along with HM to form subcommittee.
2. The docks will be removed by October 25. All boaters will have to vacate Docks A,B and C by October 22.
3. Budget concern. There was a difference between what was communicated verbally to the HM about remaining balances in the WIF and the actual balance. Town accountant is exploring the issue.
4. Main Wharf: The main wharf is sinking and will need to be repaired. This item will be further discussed at October meeting.
5. Chip Comeau, Boy Scout presented a proposal to build a 10'x16' pavilion on the gravel area adjacent to the parking lot as his Eagle project. Committee voiced unanimous consent, Mr. Comeau abstaining.
6. Organizational Vote: There were one nomination each for Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary. All were voted unanimously. Chair: Mark Guidoboni; Vice Chair Edward Gould; Secretary: Nate Murray
7. Aqualculture process was clarified for Mr. Murray. A resident had asked how to get on the list for consideration.
8. There was discussion about an end of season event for the users as a way to develop greater awareness of each other and encourage volunteer participation in the Fall and Spring. HM to explore possibilities. KWC to ask Kingston Yacht Club for support.
