The State Primary Election was held at the Kingston Elementary School for Precinct 1, 2, and 3 and at the Kingston Town Hall for Precinct 4, in accordance with the warrant issued by the Board of Selectman on August 28, 2018 and posted by Constable Robert Short on August 28, 2018.

Specimen Ballots, Penalty and instruction cards were posted at Polls in accordance with law.

The following Election Officers and Workers reported to their respective precincts. Ms. Janna Morrissey, Assistant to the Town Clerk maintained an information table at Kingston Elementary School and recorded and produced Election results.

All election workers were sworn to the faithful performance of their duties. The ballot boxes at each precinct were inspected in public by the election workers, found to be empty and a zero tape run. Keys for ballot boxes were presented to the detail police officers for the remainder of the day.

Ballots were distributed to Precincts by the Town Clerk. Sergeant Zachary Potrykus and Lt Robert Wells reported for the detail at Precinct 4 at 6:00 a.m. , at which time Sgt Potrykus escorted the Precinct 4 ballots to the Polling Stations on the second floor of Town Hall. Lt Wells escorted the Town Clerk to the Elementary school with ballots for Precincts 1,2 &3. . Lt Wells was relieved at noon by Officer John O'Neal, who remained there until 4:00p.m. at which time, Lt Wells returned. He remained on duty until ballots were escorted and delivered to Clerk's Office after the close of polls. Sgt Potrykus remained at the Town Hall along with Lt Wells until midnight.

The polls were declared open by the respective wardens at 7:00 a.m. and closed at 8:00 p.m. in accordance with the warrant. There were 243 ballots cast in Precinct One, 277 in Precinct Two, 256 in Precinct Three, and 280 cast in Precinct 4. The total cast in all four precincts was 1,056 ballots. The Town Clerk announced unofficial results to the public at 8:00 p.m. and certified the election with the Commonwealth on September 9, 2018.
